**Who:** Awarded, as a onetime scholarship, to a high school senior entering his/her first year at an accredited institution of higher education.

**Amount:** Two \$2,500 scholarships will be awarded, annually, by the 10<sup>th</sup> Mountain Division Descendants, Inc. Upon verification of enrollment, the money will be paid directly to the institution of higher education by the 10<sup>th</sup> Mountain Division Descendant Treasurer.

**Criteria:** To be considered for a Finn-Thornton Scholarship the applicant is required to submit:

- (1) The completed Application.
- (2) A one-page letter of introduction.
- (3) A copy of document verifying current membership in the 10th Descendants Inc.
- (4) A written description of completed meritorious service (i.e., community service) on behalf of the 10<sup>th</sup> Mountain Division family or reflecting the ideals and values of the 10<sup>th</sup> Mountain Division.
